COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES

- Parents and students will be notified of a change to in-person learning by JMC notification, email, and schoolinfoapp.
- Major communication will be done by the same means.
- Provide parents with Summit contact information for mental health needs.

ROTHSAY SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES

- HS students will eat in shifts with and “A” and a “B” lunch.
- Students will be given a handwashing break (at a minimum) in the morning and afternoon.
- Students kept in same grade “pods” during classes, if possible.

ROTHSAY SCHOOL STAFF RESPONSIBILITIES

- Staff will continue to educate our students.

ROTHSAY BUS RESPONSIBILITIES

- Each bus will be disinfected after each route.

PARENT/STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Parents will screen their children prior to leaving for school. A list of screening questions will be given to parents at Open House night.
- Parents will remain outside the school at pick up and drop off times.
- Parents will communicate if their child has contracted Covid-19.
- Contact the school if you have an idea to help us improve our plan.
- Contact the school counselor or Summit if your child is experiencing mental health problems.

IN THE EVENT OF A COVID-19 CASE/EXPOSURE
